IF YOU LEASE YOUR PROPERTY, BE SURE YOUR TENANT(S) ARE TAKING CARE OF THIS AND ALLOWING ACCESS TO THE PATIO!

Be sure to make your patio accessible on this date! Remove pets and/or pet access & any pet 'business'. Leave room for the techs to spray along the siding. Everyone in Texas knows termites are prevalent but you may not know that carpenter ants due as much, if not more damage here as wood destroying insects. With that said, your assistance to aide in protecting your home &your neighbors in allowing for treatment on a quarterly basis is greatly appreciated! In the end, this will help save you money. The technicians will mark their map of any units that they cannot access the patio in order to treat for carpenter ants, termites & others pests. *They do not leave a calling card!

CRIME


