Park at Quail Creek Homeowners Association Garbage Collection Service Guidelines

COLLECTION DAYS: FRIDAY

Please be sure your waste cart is out by 7:00 AM on collection day.

Waste Management furnishes each homeowner a 96-gallon poly cart, with a GREEN lid, for the collection of household garbage. Collection shall be limited to the waste cart or 7 bags, bundles or two (2) customer owned containers that are less than 40 gallons and placed within three (3) feet of the alleyway/roadway.

Important! For the safety and protection of our employees and equipment, we do require that branches and tree trimmings be no greater than three inches (3") in diameter and be cut, tied and bundled in four foot (4') lengths weighing no more than forty to fifty pounds (40-50 lbs.)

BULK TRASH COLLECTION

Two (2) items or up to two (2) cubic yards on FRIDAY of each week

Acceptable items include moving boxes (please break them down and bundle them), old furniture, appliances, grass clippings, leaves, branches and tree trimmings. Items shall be placed within three (3) feet of the alleyway/roadway

Please note! WM can no longer dispose of CFC refrigerant containing items (i.e., refrigerators, freezers, etc.) without certification that the Freon has been properly removed and recycled, pursuant to current Federal law.

Recycling Collection Service Guidelines

COLLECTION DAY: FRIDAY

Please be sure your recycle container is out by 7:00 AM on collection day.

Waste Management furnishes each homeowner a 18-gallon bin for recycle items. Bin shall be placed within three (3) feet of the alleyway/roadway. Rinse all containers thoroughly to keep recycle container clean. For additional information: http://recycleoftenrecycleright.com

Paper




Flattened Cardboard & Paperboard

Use your green cart with the GREEN lid for trash only.







KEEP THE FOLLOWING OUT OF THE RECYCLE CART: Food waste, Plastic Bags, or polystyrene foam Paper and cardboard must be dry and free of food debris. Paper food containers must be rinsed out, no caps. Make sure all containers and cans are emptied. Tissues, paper towels, and or other paper that has been in contact with food is not acceptable.
